Purpose:

The Rotary Awards given by the **Tustin-Santa Ana Rotary Club Foundation** are **financial gifts to Orange County based non-profit organizations and agencies.**

The purpose of the Rotary Awards is to provide a mechanism whereby the **Tustin-Santa Ana Rotary Club** may support and encourage organizations which promote service to the community and its residents.

Award recipients will be selected by the Board of Directors of the **Tustin-Santa Ana Rotary Club Foundation.**

Criteria:

Service to people is the aim of the Rotary Awards. The community programs should demonstrate substantial involvement of volunteers in the programs requesting aid.

Entrants should demonstrate: (i) how their project or organization best fits the motto of "***Service Above Self***"; (ii) a desire to achieve the maximum benefit-to-cost ratio; (iii) a belief in an organization exhibiting sound fiscal policy; (iv) a belief that the preponderance of financial support should come from the local community; and (v) an ability to generate revenue from multiple sources, with emphasis upon service projects for which support is limited.

Emphasis is placed, as nearly as possible, on programs providing assistance based on true need regardless of race, creed, sex or age.

Awards:

Each year a number of awards are given in amounts up to \$1,000 each. Additionally, a major award may be given in the range of \$5,000 to the entrant that best demonstrates the motto "***Service Above Self.***"

Applications:

Applications are generally received during the first quarter of each year.
